About Mike Abrashoff

When **former Naval Commander Michael Abrashoff** assumed command of the *USS Benfold*, he was the Pacific Fleet's most junior officer, leading a ship that ranked near the bottom in performance. Just one year later, the *Benfold* had soared to the top of the rankings—with the exact same crew. This remarkable transformation underscores a powerful principle: effective leadership shapes success, and a strong culture drives it all. **Michael Abrashoff's** experience inspired him to write three books, including *It's Your Ship*, which has sold over 1.3 million copies. Through his Leadership Roadmap, he shares practical, proven strategies to help anyone **spark meaningful change**. His approach focuses on *small, manageable actions* that lead to **big improvements**, empowering people at all levels to create a *more effective and positive workplace*. His transformation of the USS Benfold stands as a *testament to the impact leadership can have on a ship in the Navy*. Mike is clear: "I didn't turn the ship around—my crew did that. What I did was to create an environment where they felt safe, empowered, and supported. When you do that, anything is possible." "When my crew came to me with a problem, I'd say, 'It's your ship—how would you fix it?'. Mike zeroed in on the one thing he could control: his crew's mindset. He understood that a strong, positive culture is the most powerful advantage any organisation can have. Mike developed a management framework he calls The Leadership Roadmap. At the heart of his approach on the USS Benfold was a *shift from rigid command-and-control tactics* to a **focus on building commitment and unity**. He prioritised connecting with his crew on a deeper level, winning their hearts, minds, and loyalty through genuine conviction and humble leadership. "The most important thing that a captain can do is to see the ship through the eyes of the crew. The idea is to empower every individual to share the responsibility of achieving excellence." Mike Abrashoff's leadership principles delivered results that were nothing short of extraordinary. *Turnover on the USS Benfold plummeted to just 1%*—an unheard-of achievement. Promotions tripled, and the *crew cut operating expenses by 25%*. Recognised as the finest ship in the Pacific Fleet, the Benfold earned the prestigious [Spokane Trophy](#) for its exceptional combat readiness.

During his naval career, **Mike also helped draft the air defence strategy for U.S. forces**, including the air defence plan for naval forces in the Persian Gulf. These plans showcased his ability to *think strategically under high-stakes conditions*. Mike has authored three impactful books, beginning with *It's Your Ship*, which delivers a timeless lesson: **stop blaming outside obstacles** and focus on what you can control to achieve incredible outcomes. His follow-ups, *It's Our Ship* and *Get Your Ship Together*, explore how leaders have applied these principles to transform their own organisations. As a sought-after keynote speaker, Mike inspires audiences to challenge their assumptions about leadership and culture. Whether he's addressing **Fortune 500 executives, startups, university students, or frontline teams**, he tailors his message to topics like engagement, execution, innovation, diversity, safety, and accountability. Before commanding the Benfold, Mike served as Military Assistant to Secretary of Defence William J. Perry, helped draft air defence plans for the Persian Gulf during Iraq's invasion of Kuwait, and was executive officer on the Cruiser Shiloh, where he supported UN sanctions against Iraq. Today, Mike leads *Aegis Performance Group*, a consulting firm dedicated to helping leaders tackle challenges in leadership, talent, and performance. He and his team encourage leaders to rethink their approach, inspiring them to unlock new levels of success for themselves, their teams, and their organisations.

Top-down leadership is dead, so when the crew would present a problem, Mike became famous for responding, "What would YOU do? It's YOUR ship!" THE VIRTUAL LEADER'S ROADMAP

When Mike Abrashoff took command of one of the Navy's lowest-performing ships, he knew he had to rethink his entire leadership approach. The stakes were high—without significant improvement, the consequences could have been catastrophic for his crew. Mike responded by embracing a fresh set of guiding principles, prioritising trust, authentic engagement, and empowering his sailors. That shift in leadership transformed the USS Benfold into the Navy's top-performing ship and introduced **new ways to maximise performance**. Leaders especially

identify with Mike's journey, as it highlights strategies that can prompt leaders at all levels to drive meaningful change. Interestingly, these same principles are vital for organisations navigating the challenges of virtual work. While many have seen short-term productivity gains with remote setups, sustaining that effectiveness requires leaders to adopt new strategies. Success in this environment comes from focusing on outcomes rather than micromanaging activity and ensuring team members feel valued and recognised for their contributions. Leaders who master these skills will gain a powerful edge, building a culture of trust and accountability that thrives—whether teams are in the same room or miles apart.

NO LIMITS - DON'T LET GOALS BECOME LIMITATIONS

In our careers, it's easy to feel like we're locked in a battle to outperform a competitor or meet someone else's benchmarks. But often, the real competition is with ourselves—we just haven't realised it yet. When you're focused on beating the competition, you might aim to edge them out by a small margin—a few extra sales or a slight percentage gain. Or maybe you're handed a goal by leadership that's based on average expectations. That's exactly where Mike Abrashoff found himself when he took command of a struggling ship in the U.S. Navy. His initial objective? Simply to reach "average", he and his crew worked toward modest goals until Mike had a breakthrough moment: the real challenge wasn't external—it was about pushing past their own self-imposed limits. That shift sparked one of the most **remarkable turnarounds that was chronicled** in leadership circles, inspiring others to **rethink their beliefs about leadership**. His story encourages organisations to go beyond average and **create new ways to elevate** performance and potential. This mindset shift transformed his approach to leadership.
