[Col. Nicole Malachowski](#) isn't just known for her time in the cockpit; she's a powerhouse of leadership with an *impressive 21-year career in the Air Force*. As the first woman pilot to fly with the **Thunderbirds Air Demonstration Squadron**, she broke barriers and redefined what's possible. A mission-ready fighter pilot and **combat veteran**, she has taken her expertise to the White House as a White House Fellow and *has become a passionate advocate for health and veteran issues*. Nicole Malachowski reminds audiences of the importance of perspective in her speeches, sharing insights from her groundbreaking career. She also reflects on overcoming challenges and avoiding the constraints of a scripted life, **inspiring audiences** with her journey of perseverance, courage, and leadership.

Aviation Career and Achievements

Starting solo flights at sixteen, Nicole progressed quickly in her aviation career. She attended undergraduate pilot training, where her skills and determination were a standout. Chosen to fly combat aircraft, *she became part of the first wave of women flying modern fighter aircraft*. Throughout her service, she's logged over 2,300 flight hours in six Air Force aircraft, including milestones like her first solo flight, and had the significant responsibility of acting as a flight lead during a number of missions. Nicole's achievements have solidified her status as a career pilot, including leading the first fighter formation that secured Iraq's democratic elections in 2005. Her commitment to personal and professional excellence also earned her a place in history as the first **Air Force officer** to *join the USAF Air Demonstration Squadron*. Additionally, she served as an instructor pilot, accumulating flight time while *inspiring others with her extraordinary journey*.

Service Beyond the Air Force

Nicole's professional story began not only in the skies but also in leadership roles on the ground. *Nicole Malachowski* worked as a **White House Fellow** and later as the Executive Director of the 'Joining Forces' initiative. There, she collaborated with the Presidential Transition Support Team and advised figures like Michelle Obama and Dr Jill Biden on topics related to service members and their families. Her professional journey offers principles of **resilience and leadership** rooted in her experiences as a trailblazer in the Air Force Office and beyond. Her efforts also aligned with her involvement in organisations such as the White House Fellows Foundation and her experience as a Patient Advisory Board Member, showcasing her commitment to advocacy in the face of personal adversity, national security policy, and her connection to Seymour Johnson AFB. Additionally, her academic background at American Military University further highlights her *dedication to leadership and service*.

After being diagnosed with a severe tick-borne illness, Nicole fought tirelessly and became an advocate for others with similar diseases. She actively contributes to the LivLyne Foundation and The Dean Centre for Tick-Borne Illness, highlighting the pressing need for research and understanding in this field. Nicole Malachowski also shares inspiring personal stories of her journey, stressing perspective and emphasising the importance of both personal and professional vulnerability. In addition to her advocacy work, she is a class honour graduate, recognised for her dedication and excellence. Furthermore, the association awarded Nicole for her relentless efforts to raise awareness and inspire others battling tick-borne illnesses.

Nicole's dedication has led to multiple honours, including being named to the World Economic Forum's "Global Leaders of Tomorrow". Her achievements have also been recognised by the National Women's Hall and the Association that awarded Nicole for her trailblazing contributions. As an **elite fighter pilot** and **Air Force officer**, her career reflects the qualities celebrated in the Aviation International Pioneer Hall. *Her academic credentials are equally impressive, with two Master of Arts degrees and a top honour from the U.S. Naval War College.* Beyond her professional accolades, Nicole has inspired others, including other high school students, by sharing inspiring personal stories about her journey and the importance of leadership.
